#### **Millbrook Dairy Company Ltd**

#### **2024 International Trade**

Based in Bideford, North Devon, 8 employees, founded in 2018, Millbrook specialises in procuring and selling bulk and packaged cheese and butter across international markets. Overseas sales have grown by 109% over the last 3 years.

#### **Luminous Show Technology Ltd**

#### **2024 International Trade**

Based in Exeter with 13 employees, the Luminous team is led by its founders Mike Badley and Edwin Samkin, both qualified engineers. They provide high-end special effects for movie production and large scale live performances all over the world.

#### **Vispring Ltd**

#### **2024 International Trade**

Based in Plymouth, founded in 1901, now with over 200 employees, Vispring make luxury beds using high quality local materials. They have a deep-rooted commitment to the British farming industry and were previously awarded a Queen's Award for Enterprise in 2012.

#### Sir Fix-a-lock Ltd

#### **2024 Sustainable Development**

Based in Plymouth, Paul Montgomery started the business in 2011 while still serving in the Army having completed a locksmith course as part of his resettlement package. With 3 full time equivalent employees, they ensure all waste and old parts are fully recycled.

73% of winners in the International Trade category directly attributed increased sales to winning a Queen's Award




#### **Initial Eligibility Criteria**

#### The organisation must:

- **Ø** Be based in the UK
- May a good, continuous compliance record with HM Revenue and Customs
- **Ø** Be a self-contained enterprise
- Ø Have at least two full-time UK employees or part-time equivalents
- **Ø** Demonstrate strong corporate social responsibility

#### **Application Guidance: Top Tips**

- Check your eligibility online
- Plan your responses by downloading the pdf application form
- Use plain English
- Provide evidence of your achievements
- > TELL YOUR OWN STORY WHY DO YOU STAND OUT?
- Add 2 or more collaborators to your account
- > Allow sufficient time
- > Show quantitative and qualitative evidence to support your claim



# **Application Guidance**

#### **Innovation**



- May be an innovation that has not been sold before
- p have had your innovation available on the market for at least 2 years
- phave recovered all the investments made in your innovation or show that the innovation will recover its full costs in future
- Show outstanding commercial success as a result of innovation from 2 up to 5 years

#### Your innovation should be in one of the following categories:

- ø invention, design or production of goods
- performance of services
- marketing and distribution
- ø after-sale support of goods or services

#### **Your story:**

- What was the situation which led to your innovation?
- What are the challenges you have overcome
- Why is your innovation unique
- Mow does your innovation benefit your business, customers and others



### **Application Guidance**

#### International Trade

#### To apply for the International Trade award, you must:

- phave made a minimum of £100,000 in overseas sales in the first year of your entry and show year-on-year growth
- prove that your organisation has achieved outstanding growth in overseas earnings relative to your business size and sector
- prove steep year-on-year growth (without dips) in overseas sales over 3 years - or substantial year-on-year growth (without dips) over 6 years

#### Your story:

- Why is penetration of a particular market an achievement? E.g. are you the first, leading, fastest growing UK exporter in this market?
- Why is your performance better than that of competitors?
- What challenges have effected your trade and how you overcame them?

**Promoting Opportunity** (through Social **Mobility**)

# Guidance

#### To apply for the Promoting Opportunity award, you must:

have supported people from disadvantaged backgrounds in improving their job skills and their chances of finding work.

#### This includes doing one or more of the following, for at least 2 years:

- providing work experience or careers advice
- mentoring
- offering interview and job-related training
- making sure your recruitment process is open to everyone

This Award is open to organisations engaged in enterprise who are positively supporting social mobility. The Award is **not aimed at those whose core** purpose is to improve social mobility. Not-for-profit businesses, social enterprises and charities are welcome to apply.

If you are a training provider or educational organisation, you can only apply if you are submitting a joint application with a business, or if you have a social mobility initiative for your own workforce / employees.



# **Application Guidance**

#### Sustainable Development



#### To apply for the Sustainable Development Award, you must:

- Show how you have achieved outstanding sustainable development for more than 2 years
- Provide evidence of the benefits or positive outcomes of your actions or interventions
- If you have a sustainable product or approach, you must also demonstrate a sustainable business strategy.

In the **Sustainable Development application** you may want to tell us about any specific successes, such as developing an innovative new product or process delivering environmental benefits, or seeing sustainable development outcomes embedded in your organisation, supply chain or community.

It is important to demonstrate that your company and/or senior decision makers are leading the way in your sector or community and how they have overcome important challenges that are specific to your sector.

#### Your story:

- What are you doing to be sustainable, in particular, compared to your competitors?
- Ø How are you leading the way and influencing others to be more sustainable?
- Restore, recycle, regenerate and the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals

#### How to apply

- Almost all UK businesses (including non-profit) can apply
- The application process is free
- All applications must be made online
- You may apply for more than one category
- Applications for the 2025 King's Awards for Enterprise are open from
   6 May until midday 12 September 2024
